BEWARE TEMPTING OFFERS

People in Sussex are being warned by Trading Standards to be on their guard against a Company that uses a premium rate telephone number. **Studio Telecom** send out postcards, similar in design to a Royal Mail Collection Card, that tells people that a parcel addressed to them could not be delivered and invites the person to call a certain number to arrange collection. However, the small print on the card says that the call line charges are £1.50 per minute and could last up to five minutes. The cards state the product and it is usually listed as an attractive item like a digital camera.

Although the Company is not acting illegally people should be wary if they receive this type of postcard. Read the small print on any card sent through the post before making any telephone calls.

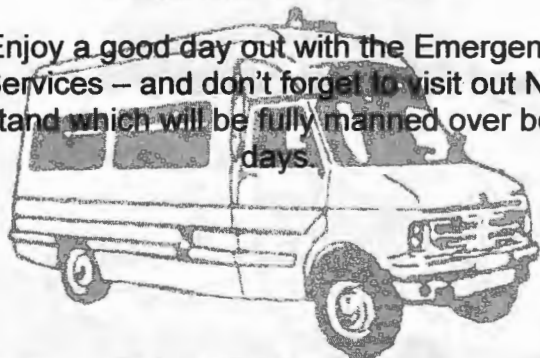

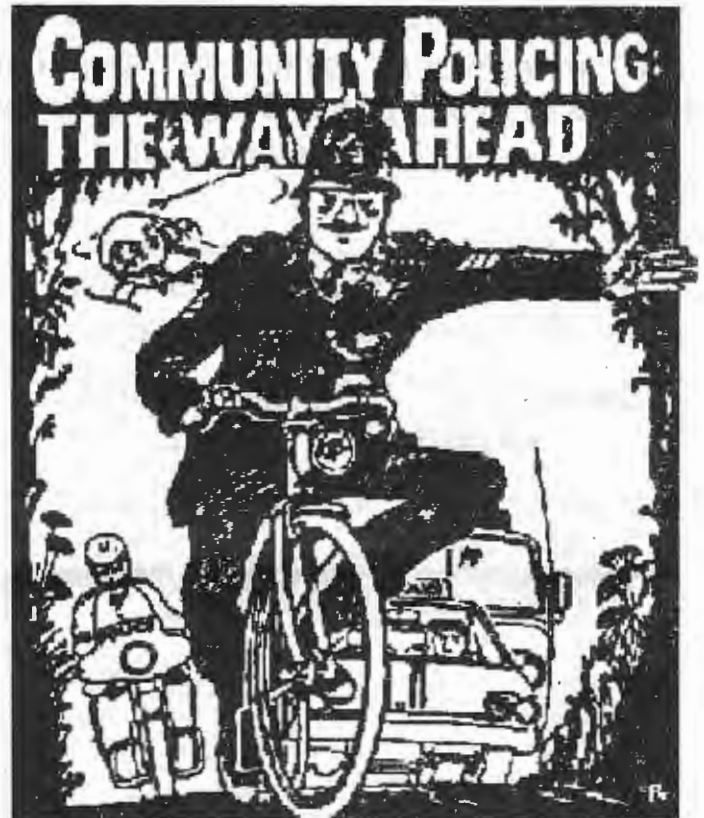
